**REGARDING: Notice of Regional Directors Election Meeting
Now Accepting Letters of Intent**

Dear CFRW Board of Directors, Club Presidents and Members,

The letter will serve as notice that your Regional Director will be convening a meeting in August 2021 for the purpose of electing the 2022/2023 CFRW Regional Director for your Region. Additional information regarding date, time, place and type of meeting (in person or electronic) will be emailed to you by your Regional Director.

The following information is being provided for your review and consideration; please note the eligibility requirements for Regional Director Candidates.

Your Regional Director is now accepting Letters of Intent for the election of Regional Directors for 2022-2023.

Please submit your Letter of Intent and resume by email to your current Regional Director and copy to CFRW Parliamentarian, Lois Godfrey. Email addresses for all Regional Directors and our CFRW Parliamentarian can be found at the end of this letter.

Deadline for Letters of Intent and all supporting documents must be received by July 31, 2021.

ARTICLE VII – OFFICERS AND DUTIES

A. OFFICERS

Section 1. Eligibility

- a. Elected and appointed CFRW Statewide Officers, **Regional Directors** all Committees shall be local federated club members in good standing, **residing and registered to vote in California.**
- b. A candidate may run for only one office in a CFRW statewide election.
- c. An elected or appointed member of the CFRW Executive Committee shall not hold an elective office in another national or state chartered Republican Organization. This shall not preclude membership or holding office on the State or County Central Committees.

ARTICLE XI—NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS

B. NOMINATIONS REGIONAL DIRECTORS

Regional Director Eligibility

- a. To be eligible for the office of Regional Director, a member shall be residing in her designated region. She shall have served as President of a local club for at least one term.
- b. Local Clubs may submit names of members that meet required qualifications to their Regional Director by the designated deadline.

C. ELECTIONS

Section 1. Elections for Statewide Elected Officers shall be by ballot of the accredited delegates at the Biennial Convention. A plurality vote shall elect. Each delegate shall have one (1) vote for each statewide candidate.

Section 2. Elections for Regional Directors shall be held within their Region no later than forty-five (45) days prior to the Biennial Convention.

Section 3. To qualify to elect a Regional Director, each local club that has been a member in good standing in CFRW for at least ninety days (90) days prior to voting in their designated region shall be represented by its President or Vice President (in their order) or a delegate elected by their Executive Committee, and one delegate and alternate for the first ten (10) members and one (1) delegate and alternate for each additional ten (10) members or major fraction thereof.

Section 4. If there is only one (1) candidate for an office, the ballot may be dispensed with by general consent and the election held by voice vote.

Section 5. Statewide Elected Officers, Appointed Officers, and Regional Directors shall assume their duties on January 1 following their election.

Section 6. Ballots shall be destroyed at the close of the Biennial Convention.

ARTICLE VII—OFFICERS AND DUTIES

B. DUTIES

Section 12. Regional Directors shall:

- a. serve on the Executive Committee;
- b. be members of the CFRW Membership Extension Committee;
- c. implement the statewide membership promotion plan approved by the Executive Committee;
- d. focus on membership promotion within their Region;
- e. be the liaison between CFRW Executive Committee, Board of Directors, and clubs in their Region;
- f. make oral or written reports at the request of the President;
- g. if feasible, visit each club at least once during her term in office;
- h. communicate monthly, via any type of communication method, with club presidents in their Region;
- i. hold a biennial regional meeting to elect the next Regional Director;
- j. supervise the formation of new clubs in their Region;
- k. perform such other duties as may be assigned by the President and the Executive Committee.
